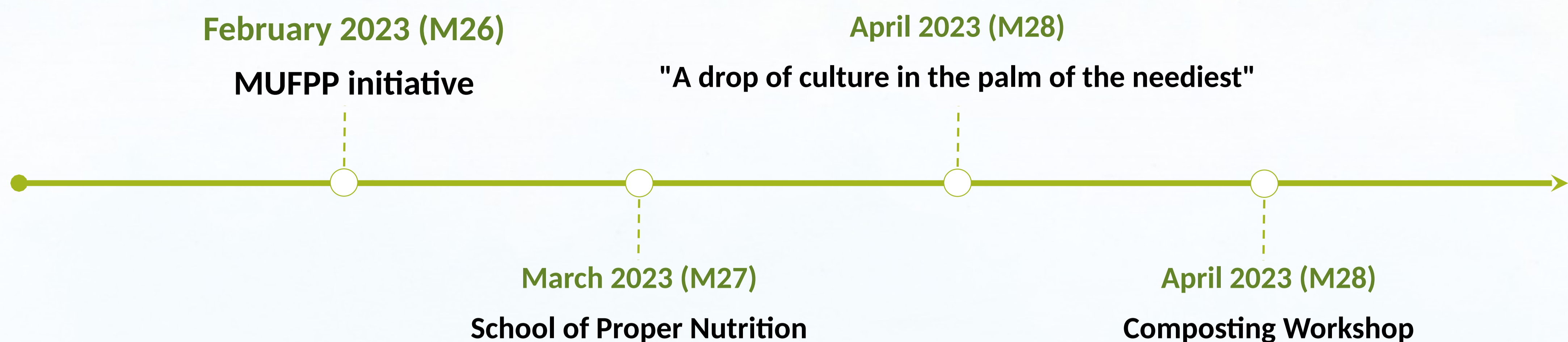

Charity concert



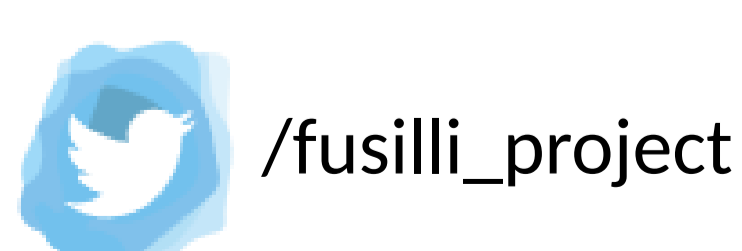
