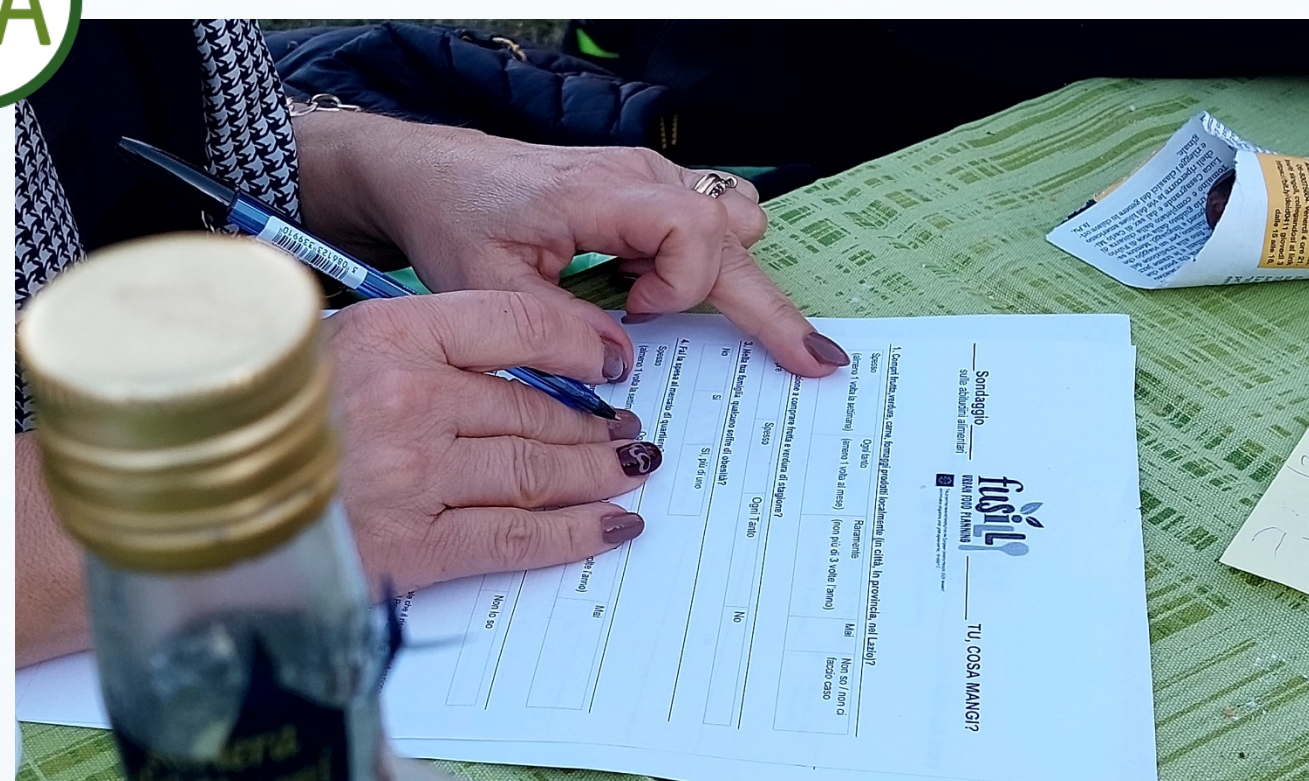

127 Markets' islands to fight food poverty

After months of work by the Municipal and the 15 Boroughs' Commissions and by the Living Lab, the Regulation 46/2023 for City Public Markets was approved in May 2023. An important amendment inserted encourages the active role of citizens by dedicating 12 sqm in each of the 127 Markets to socially useful civic projects such as the recovery of food surpluses for a concrete aid network for those in need.

Zero waste from restaurants to charities

With Resolution 187 of December 2022, the City encourages restaurants, canteens and businesses that present projects to donate food surpluses by recognizing a reduction in the waste fees. FUSILLI supports this policy thanks to its stakeholders with many awareness raising, education and effective activities on the recovery and redistribution of leftovers and surpluses to the needy from markets, events and restaurants.
